## Qualification

Graduates of the Certificate in Automotive Engineering will also gain credits in National Certificate within the Motor Industry

## Further study options

Once you have completed the Certificate in Automotive Engineering, you will have the confidence to take on further study options. Enrol in the Certificate in Automotive Engineering (Advanced) or a range of other courses offered at Whitireia New Zealand

## Entry criteria

- Must be a school leaver between 16 and 17 years of age as at 7 February 2012
- Can be turning 18 years of age on or after 8 February 2012 and still be eligible
- Must enrol in full-time study in 2012
- Must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- Must have 8 credits NCEA Level 1 in each of numeracy and literacy units or equivalent
