SCHOLARSHIPS ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS

The Whitireia Foundation is pleased to offer a number of scholarships to Whitireia students who are studying fulltime.

Scholarships are offered to school leavers and Whitireia students continuing their studies. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of merit and perseverance to succeed in spite of personal circumstances.

All applications must meet the Whitireia Foundation Scholarship conditions and eligibility criteria.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must be enrolling on a fulltime / full year programme at Whitireia Community Polytechnic and have recently completed at least 20 weeks of fulltime study at the polytechnic—or previous study if otherwise specified.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- ◆ Closing date for applications are the 24 September 2010 (unless otherwise specified).
- ◆ All applications must be signed, dated and have all the following supporting documents in order to be considered:
 - Completed, signed and dated application form
 - CV
 - 2 Faculty reports (Current WCP students) or 2 References (Non-WCP students)
 - Photograph (passport sized, copy of student id photo is acceptable)
- ◆ The scholarships will be awarded by Whitireia Foundation on the basis that the information supplied in any application is true and correct. The Foundation reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship if the information is proved to be incorrect.
- ◆ A Scholarship must be taken up in the year for which it is offered.
- ◆ The Whitireia Foundation reserves the right to not award any scholarships should the Trustees decide that there are no eligible candidates.
- ◆ The decision of the Trustees is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

MONETARY TRANSACTION CONDITIONS

- ◆ Whitireia Scholarship funds are strictly to be used to pay for the Course fees as outlined in the recipients application unless otherwise requested by the sponsor.
- ◆ Recipients are expected to pay Programme fees on enrolment and scholarship funds will be credited to their Whitireia student account after the receipt of the award at the Whitireia Foundation Scholarship Ceremony.
- ◆ The recipient withdraws or transfers to another programme, it is expected that the scholarship will be repaid to the Foundation.

ATTENDANCE AT THE WHITIREIA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS CEREMONY

- ◆ Recipients and their families will be invited to attend an awards ceremony to be held early in the academic year. Recipients are expected to attend to receive their scholarship awards.
- ◆ If any recipient cannot attend, they are required to send a person to accept the award on their behalf. The scholarship will be forfeit if this requirement is not met.

PROGRESS DOCUMENTATION

An achievement statement will be required from you and a tutor at the end of the scholarship year.
